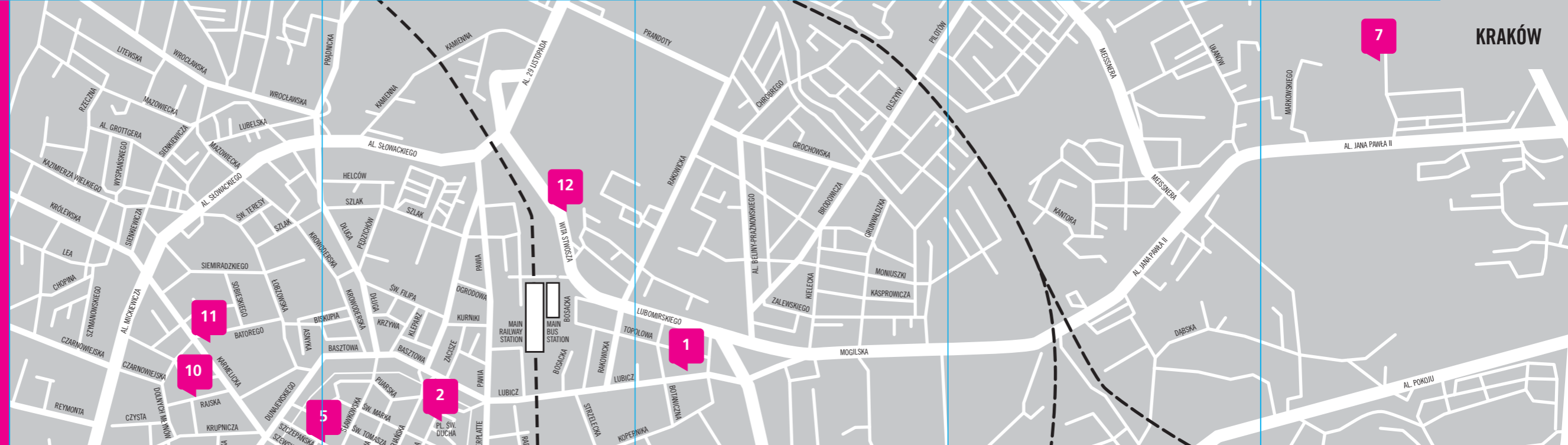
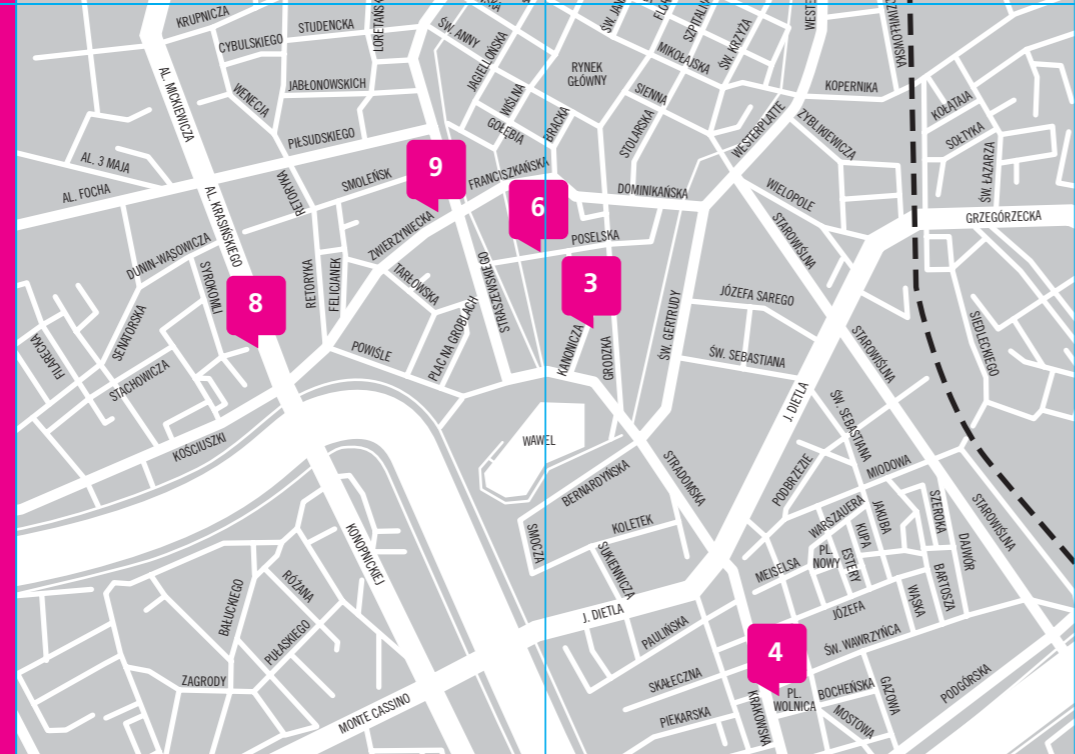

JULIUSZ SŁOWACKI THEATRE IN KRAKÓW

The Slowacki Theatre, which has continued to operate since 1893, is one of the most highly regarded Polish dramatic stages. The Theatre offers important, worthwhile shows that vigorously comment on the present day but also creatively refer to Polish and European tradition. The Theatre is also home to the famous poetry salon – Krakowski Salon Poezji hosted by Anna Dymna and the open-air stage Scena Przy Pompie and Scena w Bramie – the stage "off" projects.

CRICOTEKA CENTRE FOR THE DOCUMENTATION OF THE ART OF TADEUSZ KANTOR IN KRAKÓW

Cricoteka is an institution that simultaneously functions as museum, gallery, scientific unit and archive. It was established in 1980 by Tadeusz Kantor (1915-1990), painter, drawer, art theoretician, stage designer and director, author of happenings, distinguished reformer of the theatre and one of the most important figures of artistic life in the Poland of the 20th century.

MUSEUM OF ARCHAEOLOGY IN KRAKÓW

The Museum is the oldest archaeological museum in Poland. It was established as the Museum of Antiquity in February 1850. In the 19th century the collections were started with numerous donations from society, while after the Museum's establishment the collections came mainly from excavations carried out by the Museum, independently or in collaboration with other institutions.

Permanent exhibitions:

- Prehistory and early Middle Ages in Małopolska,
- Gods of ancient Egypt,
- Oldest and old history of the building of the Museum of Archaeology in Kraków,
- Peruvian collections of Władysław Kluger.

Temporary exhibitions:

- Archaeological motorway – excavations conducted at the large road investments near Kraków,
- Exiles to Siberia,
- Secret places in the Gdańsk courtyards.

POLISH AVIATION MUSEUM IN KRAKÓW

The Museum is located at one of the oldest European airfields, that has been growing up since 1912 and operated until 1963. Today in the historical setting of the created Aviation Cultural Park the Museum visitors meet contemporary aviation technique and the history of aviation, and can see the collected aircraft.

Permanent exhibitions:

- Main Building – history of aviation,
- Small Hangar – World War I aircraft,
- Main Hangar – aviation from the 1930s to the present,
- History Storehouses – pioneers of flight,
- Open-air exhibition – "MiG Alley",
- Between East and West – Cold War aircraft.

THE TATRA MUSEUM IN ZAKOPANE

Museum in Zakopane and its 10 branches – everything about the Tatra Mountains, Podtatrze and Zakopane. Historical buildings, permanent and temporary exhibitions. Highlanders' culture, works of artists associated with Zakopane, history of Podhale and natural environment of the Tatra Mountains.
